## ADVENT PRISONERS OF CONSCIENCE CARDS

As with every year in Advent, parishioners will be invited to send a Christmas card to one of four prisoners of conscience (POCs), representing the many hundreds all over the world in jail for their beliefs. Your message will let them know that they are not forgotten. On the weekends of 9/10<sup>th</sup> and 16/17<sup>th</sup> December handouts with details of the POCs will be distributed at all Masses, encouraging you to send a card with your own message of hope to one of them and then post it yourself. All the details and addresses are on the handout. It costs £2.20 to send a card to any country around the world. *Some beautiful cards made by a young parishioner will be for sale in the hall after Mass in St Mary's for £0.50.* 

#### PRAYERS FOR PEACE IN ISRAEL AND GAZA

Every Friday evening till Christmas, Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament in St. Joseph's, will be set aside for **Prayers for Peace in Israel and Gaza**. We will say the five sorrowful mysteries of the Rosary from about 6.25pm interspersed with prayers for peace. Before rosary and then after rosary there is time for private prayer for the civilian populations on both sides, caught up in this horrendous war.

We pray for a just peace because peace without justice, cannot be sustained.

As we do not have crib offerings here in St Joseph's and St Mary's, we will be donating monies received in the November Dead List envelopes to these two charities. The amount raised from the Mass envelopes was £817.50.
