WALK WITH ME – LENT 2024.

This pocket size booklet of prayer and reflections for Lent is now available at the back of the both churches. Cost £1. With a foreword by Archbishop Mark O'Toole, it provides us with an aid to prayer on our Lenten Journey. He says: "This year we celebrate Lent within the context the Year of Prayer, a year of preparation for the Jubilee Year, entitled Pilgrims of Hope. We are asked to make the Lord's Prayer a particular focus, deepening our understanding of and our devotion to it". This is what we do on our Walk With Me journey through Lent. "The Lord's Prayer reminds us of that wonderful truth that we are children of God, loved by the Father in Heaven, and thus we enter into Jesus' own relationship with his Father. God is our Father who loves us more than we can imagine, and who comes to search for us lost sheep, and draws us back to Him through the death and resurrection of His Son. What better way of living Lent than by truly entering into this prayer more deeply".

LENT 2024 ASH WEDNESDAY

There will be two Masses on Ash Wednesday with the blessing and distribution of Ashes, both are in St. Joseph's – at 10am and 7.30pm respectively. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days marked by penance – in particular by fasting and abstinence from meat.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS AND BENEDICTION

On the six Sundays of Lent, up to and including Palm Sunday, there will be the traditional Stations of the Cross and Benediction, beginning at 4pm in St. Joseph's.
