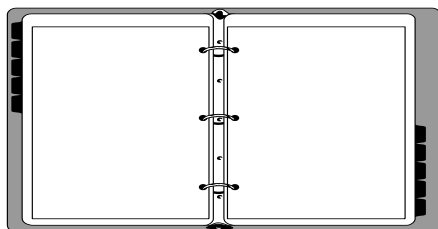

CAFOD welcomes overseas speaker Fr Pius to South Wales as part of his tour around the UK. He will be hosting an afternoon fundraiser on **Wednesday 22nd April** from 3.30pm to 5pm. All the money raised will go to disaster prevention from which his community has benefited in the past. There will be an opportunity to hear about Fr Pius' work with Caritas Pathein, Myanmar (Burma) with poor and vulnerable communities in the Diocese of Pathein. Fr Pius' work ranges from helping people in his diocese to increase their job opportunities and income, increase their access to healthcare, increase their understanding of their basic human rights, and help communities to mitigate disasters through supporting the development of emergency preparedness plans.
