PUBLIC MASSES RETURN THIS WEEKEND.

Weekend Masses with a congregation will re-commence in St. Joseph's from this weekend. These Masses will still be subject to social distancing etc. and are therefore restricted to 50 persons per Mass. Admission will be on a "first come" basis, so please come early. All these Masses will continue to be streamed live to your computer. The weekday Masses – Mon, Wed, and Fri - will continue to be streamed live only, albeit without a congregation. We are grateful to our Stewards whose presence makes all this possible. Hopefully, as further restrictions are eased in May and June, we can slowly get parish life back on track with a greater degree of normality.

With the church doors closed to a congregation since Christmas, no offertory collection has been possible during that time. GIFT AID AND NON GIFT AID ENVELOPES.

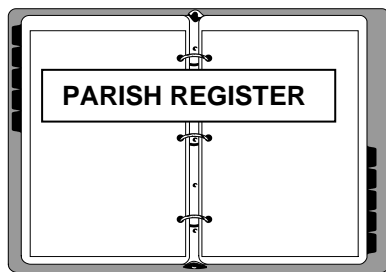

We are hoping to re-start the sacramental preparation programmes after Easter, with a view to celebrating those Sacraments later in the summer. REQUESTS FOR MASS INTENTIONS.

If you are thinking of requesting a Mass to be said for a loved one who has died, or someone dear whose anniversary occurs on a specific date in the near future, then please bear in mind that the Mass diary is full for the next seven weeks ahead. This is due to the fact that there have been less Masses than normal being said during the lockdown. The only way Mgr Joe can cope with the proliferation of Mass requests is to ask you not to specify the particular date on its own, but rather to qualify it by saying "or as soon as possible". Thank you.
