MANCHESTER AND LONDON

Message from Archbishop George

We have all been shocked by the brutal events which have taken place in **Manchester** and **London** recently. I have been in contact both with **Bishop John Arnold of Salford** and **Archbishop Peter Smith of Southwark** offering them our solidarity and prayers. In condemning such acts of violence, **our responsibility as a people of faith** is surely to engage with members of other communities, some of whom feel alienated from society at large and the institutions we cherish. Words and actions which **express solidarity** in the face of such violence have an enormous contribution to make towards creating a civilised society.

DAY FOR LIFE – 18th June (NEXT WEEK)

In October it will be **50 years** since the passing of the **1967 Abortion Act** in Wales, Scotland and England. This **sad anniversary** will be marked in various ways. The **Day for Life** this year will provide us with an **opportunity to pray for and remember** all those lives lost before birth and to offer practical, spiritual and emotional support to **women and men** who have been **affected by issues surrounding abortion** or who are worried and concerned about unwanted pregnancy. For those who have had an abortion, the words of **Pope Francis** will be a comfort and a challenge: "...there is no sin that God's mercy cannot reach and wipe away when it finds a repentant heart seeking to be reconciled to the Father". More information including prayers is available from: www.dayforlife.org. There will be a **second collection** on **18th June** to support the work of Day for Life. Proceeds from this collection are allocated to the **Anscombe Bioethics Centre** and other Church supported life activities.

MINISTRIES SUNDAY: 24th – 25th June

On the weekend of the 24th-25th June Canon Joe will be re-commissioning **Eucharistic Ministers** and **Ministers of the Word (Readers)** during Mass. There are many other forms of ministry in the parish and they are all equally valuable. However, these two ministries are the main ministries exercised during the Sacred Liturgy (whilst also recognising the ministry of music and altar servers, of course). Canon would like as many of those ministers as possible to be present at one or other of the four Masses that weekend. If, for whatever reason, a Eucharistic Minister or a Reader cannot be there, would they please let Canon Joe know that they are willing to continue for the coming year. He is grateful to all who exercise ministries in the parish for their commitment and dedication. We are truly blessed.
