### DAY FOR LIFE NEXT WEEKEND.

The Church teaches that life is to be nurtured from conception to natural death. In England and Wales, Day for Life is celebrated on the third Sunday of June each year. This year it falls on 18<sup>th</sup> June.

The theme is "Listen to her" and focuses on post-abortion trauma and the impact of abortion primarily on women, but also men and others.

A second collection will be taken at each Mass. The funds raised also support the Anscombe Bio-Ethics Centre which advises the Bishops' Conference on medical issues.

### STREET LIGHTS ON ASH PATH - PETITION

Marianne Cowpe from Dinas Powys, is a Vale Councillor and she is asking parishioners if they would consider signing a petition which will go to the Vale Council asking them to provide street lighting on the Ash Path. In the winter months in particular, this path is dark for schoolchildren and others using the path to walk from Penarth to Dinas Powys and vice versa. It is dangerous too. She will be collecting signatures again outside St Mary's church after the 11.15am Mass this Sunday. There will also be petition forms at the back of St. Joseph's at the other Masses.


