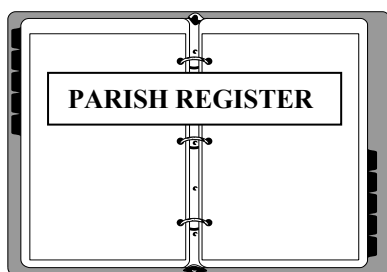
**Your Cafod envelopes or a donation** can be placed in the Special CAFOD collection buckets that are positioned at the back of both churches **this week**.

- they can give via **TEXT**. Text CAFOD to 70085 to donate £10. Texts cost £10 plus one standard rate message. If you would like to give £10 but don't want any marketing follow-up, you can text instead: CAFODNOINFO to 70085.
- they can **POST** their envelopes through the presbytery door in Penarth.

### WORLD MISSION SUNDAY (October 18<sup>th</sup>) BUT IT WILL BE DELAYED BY ONE WEEK.

Next week, the whole church unites in prayer for its missionary activity, and in collecting funds to support Catholic communities across the world living in situations of privation, and lacking financial and medical resources. **However, because of its proximity to the Cafod Fast Day, the World Mission Sunday collection will be delayed until the following weekend of 24<sup>th</sup> / 25<sup>th</sup> October.** An extra collection bucket will be placed alongside the "Parish Offertory" on the day, for your donations as you leave the church.

### NOVEMBER MASSES FOR THE HOLY SOULS.

During November, daily Masses will be offered for the Holy Souls. This year is different of course because we cannot distribute the special envelopes for your dead lists. However Mgr. Joe will place a symbolic number of **empty** November envelopes in the box on the altar from November 2<sup>nd</sup> in both our churches. **They represent the envelopes and lists that you brought in last year.** The Lord knows to whom they belong, and whose names were in them. **So if you brought in an envelope last year, with your list of deceased loved ones, then one of the empty ones this year is allocated to you. There is no further action required.** Alternatively, if you want to send in a list, then please post it to the presbytery in Penarth, or push it through the door. **They will be placed in one of the empty envelopes. You should not enclose any cash.**
