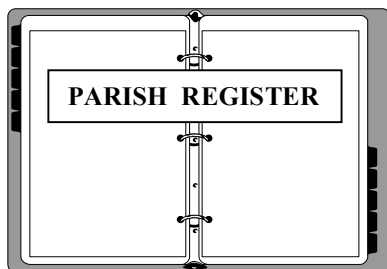
DEACON ELFED IS AWAY
