THE SEASON OF CREATION continues.

In his encyclical "Laudato Si," Pope Francis says that as Christians we cannot be indifferent to the climate and ecological emergency. Living our vocation to be protectors of God's handiwork is essential to a life of virtue. It is not an optional or a secondary aspect of our Christian experience.

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED FOR BUS ESCORTS

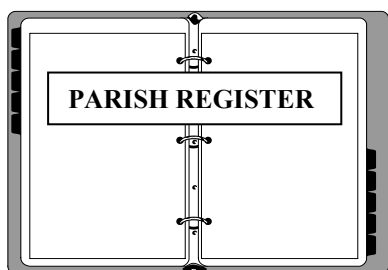
