Holy Week - Day by Day

On Monday – Mass will be in St. Joseph's at 9.30am
On Tuesday – Mass will be in St. Mary's at 9.30am
On Wednesday morning – the Chrism Mass takes place in
St. David's Cathedral, Cardiff at 11.30am
On Wednesday evening – the Mass of the Day will take
place in St. Mary's, Dinas Powys at 7.00pm

The Triduum: begins on **Maundy Thursday** evening with Mass of the Lord's Supper at 7.30pm in St. Joseph's, followed by Eucharistic Adoration at the Altar of Repose (Lady Chapel) until 10.30pm. At 10.15pm the 5 Sorrowful Mysteries of the Holy Rosary will be recited, taking us from the Garden of Gethsemane to Calvary.

On **Good Friday** at 3pm in St. Joseph's we resume our journey in the footsteps of our Blessed Lord with the Solemn Good Friday Liturgy.

On **Holy Saturday** - at the Easter Vigil Mass in St. Joseph's at 8.30pm, our Catechumen, NICHOLAS ABBOTT, will receive the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and the Eucharist, joining us at the table of the Lord for the very first time.
