'We care about women'

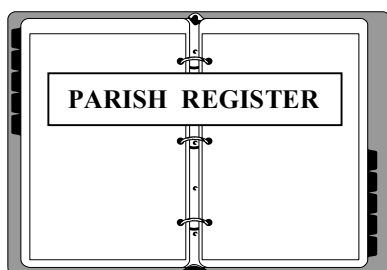
