

ASSISTED DYING BILL

Please write to a member of the House of Lords. The Bill to legalise "assisted dying" (meaning assisted suicide) will be debated in the House of Lords on **18**th **July**. There will be a free vote because it is not government legislation. If passed, this Bill would place vulnerable people at serious risk. Please write **before** 18th July to a Peer to tell them your views, especially if you have direct experience of caring for a dying person, either as a family member or as a social care professional.
