THE ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY (Holy Day of Obligation – Tues Aug 15)

God loves human beings. We are not souls in disposable wrappings, but whole people: flesh and blood, scars and wrinkles; feelings, dreams and memories. We are people with families; people with histories; people with both good qualities and flaws. Human imperfection is nonetheless infused with the divine. As Julian of Norwich said six centuries ago, to be human is to be “a muddle so marvellous, lovable and exasperating all at the same time”. Ours may be a slower transition than Mary’s into eternal life, and only fully completed when we reach heaven, but we will get there in the end, we can be sure of that. **Mass times on Tuesday in St. Joseph’s are: 10am and 7.30pm.** There is a **coffee morning** in St. Joseph’s hall after the 10am Mass. SAINT OF THE WEEK

St. Maximilian Kolbe – Monday 14th August

Maximilian Maria Kolbe OFM Conv. (born Raymund Kolbe; (1894 – 1941) was a Polish Catholic priest and Conventual Franciscan Friar who volunteered to die in place of a man named Franciszek Gajowniczek in the German death camp of Auschwitz, located in German-occupied Poland during World War II. He had been active in promoting the veneration of the Immaculate Virgin Mary, founding and supervising the monastery of Niepokalanów near Warsaw, operating an amateur-radio station (SP3RN), and founding or running several other organizations and publications.

On 10 October 1982, Pope John Paul II canonized Kolbe and declared him a Martyr of Charity. The Catholic Church venerates him as the patron saint of amateur radio operators, drug addicts, political prisoners, families, journalists, and prisoners. John Paul II declared him "the patron of our difficult century". His feast day is 14 August, the day of his death.

Due to Kolbe's efforts to promote consecration and entrustment to Mary, he is known as the Apostle of Consecration to Mary.
