Next Sunday – Home Mission Sunday – a second collection will be taken.

On Sunday 20th **September** the Catholic Bishops of England and Wales ask that Home Mission Sunday is celebrated in every parish to invite prayer and support for the work of evangelisation.

Here are four ways of responding to next Sunday's Gospel – in our lives, in our families, in our parishes and by reaching out to non-churchgoing Catholics. We have to allow ourselves to be called by God to whatever acts of witness he wants from us. Pope Francis says: evangelisation "is first and foremost the Lord's work, surpassing anything we can see and understand. In every act of evangelisation, the primacy always belongs to God, who has called us to cooperate with him and who leads us on by the power of his Spirit" (EG 12).
