COMING OUT OF LOCKDOWN.

The Welsh Government has now given its "road map" out of lockdown which is cautious in its approach and will be ongoing. Now that the "Stay at Home" mantra has been dropped, Mgr. Joe will be re-introducing Mass-with-acongregation in St. Joseph's as soon as he can – but not immediately. Arrangements will be made to re-commence Mass with a congregation immediately after Easter. So from the weekend of **April 11th/12**th the Saturday and Sunday Masses (ie. 5pm Sat and 9.30am Sun) will be open to parishioners. These Masses will still be subject to current coronavirus restrictions of 50 persons per Mass. We will be going back to the format for Mass that we became so used to before the last lockdown.

HOLY WEEK AND THE TRIDUUM.

The celebration of Holy Week and Easter is obviously going to be different this year, as the Holy Week Services themselves have to be adapted to the prevailing pandemic precautions. However, each of the Services in Holy week - and Easter itself - will conform to the specific guidance that we have received from the Bishops' Conference of England and Wales.

Each of the Triduum Services will be streamed live from St. Joseph's at the published times, but only those who are actually taking part in the liturgies can be present. More information will be given nearer the time.



On the anniversary of the first lockdown due to coronavirus, Archbishop George will celebrate a special Mass for those who have died as a consequence of the pandemic. The Solemn Requiem Mass will be celebrated at the Cathedral at 12.45pm on **Tuesday 23rd March**. There are 34 spaces available in the Cathedral for "a person, or their bubble". These seats will be reserved on a first-come-first-served basis.
