Monday - Mass will be said in St. Joseph's at 9.30am

Wednesday morning - Chrism Mass at 11.30am at St. David's Cathedral, Charles Street, Cardiff.

Wednesday evening - Mass of the Day in St. Mary's at 7pm.

THE TRIDUUM

This begins on **MAUNDY THURSDAY** evening with the **Mass of the Lord's Supper** at 7.30pm in **St. Joseph's**. This is followed by **Eucharistic Adoration** at the Altar of Repose (Lady Chapel) **until 10.30pm**. At **10.15pm** the **Sorrowful Mysteries** of the **Holy Rosary** will be recited, taking us from the Garden of Gethsemane to Calvary.

GOOD FRIDAY at 3pm - We resume our journey in the footsteps of **Our Blessed Lord** with the **Solemn Good Friday Liturgy** in **St. Joseph's**.

HOLY SATURDAY at 8.30pm – We celebrate with joy together the **Easter Vigil Mass** in **St. Joseph's**. (During the Vigil Mass our candidate Robert Williams will be received into Full Communion with the Catholic Church).

CHRISM MASS IN CATHEDRAL

The **Chrism Mass** will take place in **St. David's Cathedral** on the **Wednesday of Holy Week (17th April)** at **11.30am**. At this Mass the priests of the Archdiocese renew their priestly vows and the **Archbishop will bless the Holy Oils** that are used throughout the parishes of the diocese.

HOLY PLACES COLLECTION – Good Friday

The traditional Holy Places Collection will take place at the Solemn Liturgy on Good Friday. This collection is for the Latin Patriarch for the upkeep of the shrines and to maintain a Christian presence and pastoral outreach in Jerusalem.

THE SHROUD OF TURIN EXHIBITION

From 6th – 20th April, and throughout Holy Week, there is a unique opportunity to visit the Shroud of Turin Exhibition, which is being held in the chapel at Nazareth House. Opening times are from 10.30am until 5pm each day. On Sundays, the image of the shroud will be on display from midday until 5pm. This is a unique opportunity to see the only life size replica of the shroud in the UK. Speaking of the shroud, Pope Francis said: "The icon of this love is the shroud that, even now, has attracted so many people to Turin. The shroud draws people to the tormented face and body of Jesus and, at the same time, directs people towards the face of every suffering and unjustly persecuted person".
