PRIEST TRAINING FUND APPEAL NEXT WEEK

Those who decide to train for the priesthood have made a commitment to our faith. The calibre of those who have answered God's call to serve as priests gives us hope for the future. We must prepare these men as best we can for all the challenges that the world can throw at them. As a church we are committed to ensuring that they receive robust preparation under the guidance of expert mentors. The challenge of a lifelong commitment to serve God and God's people is daunting. But those who enter seminary know that they are supported by family and friends in their home diocese. Priests are called to live simple lives but high-quality training comes at a price. On average the Archdiocese of Cardiff invests £189.000 in the formation of each seminarian over seven years. Yet following ordination a priest may give back more than 40 or 50-years' service, so the investment brings a considerable return.
