Today we would have been celebrating the gift of the Eucharist in our Sunday Masses. And the highlight of our Mass would have been the receiving of Holy Communion. Sadly this year, this wonderful feast is a poignant reminder to us that our churches remain closed and we cannot celebrate the Mass and the Sacraments together at this time, because of the Coronavirus pandemic.

It is the same for all our Catholic people of course, and not just for parishioners of St. Joseph's and St. Mary's, who have been deprived of Eucharistic communion with the Lord for so many weeks now, and have missed the warmth of the Eucharistic Community to which they belong.

I think it is true to say that one of the ways this pandemic has changed us, is that now we will appreciate more, the things we previously took for granted. Our priorities have changed. Material things are no substitute for the health and wellbeing of our families and loved ones. People are worried about the effects of Covid-19 on their jobs and livelihoods, as well as on the education of their children. What the new “normal” will be, as and when we eventually emerge from this imposed lockdown, we just don't know. What we do know, however, is that we all face an uncertain future.

How fortunate we are as Catholics, to have our belief in the real and abiding presence of Jesus in the Eucharist to hold onto in the midst of this uncertainty. With our belief undimmed, we can see the future through the eyes of our faith, and having seen and believed, we then have hope for that future, whatever it might bring.

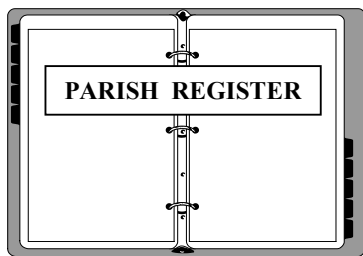
