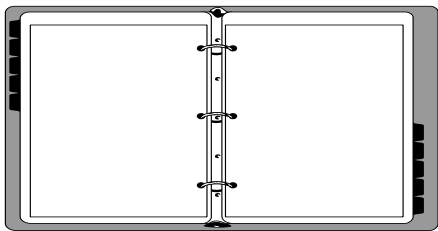

### Home Mission Sunday Collection– Next Weekend

Theme: *Evangelisation 'in the heart of the family'*.

### SVP England and Wales – Month of Awareness.

September marks the annual "Awareness Month" of the SVP, culminating in **the feast of St. Vincent de Paul on 27<sup>th</sup> September**. Here in the Archdiocese of Cardiff we are blessed with very active and effective conferences of the SVP as well as their Charity shops. This is not a fundraising exercise, but an invitation to Catholic people to explore ways in which they might share in the caring apostolate which is at the centre of the life of the Church and close to the heart of Pope Francis.

The St. Vincent de Paul Society in England and Wales has around 10,000 members who, last year, made nearly 500,000 visits to those in need.

During this September Awareness Month the theme this year is **"Concern is Not Enough"**.
