### REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY – DINAS POWYS.

The annual Service of Remembrance with the laying of wreaths, will take place at The Twyn, Dinas Powys, **today 14<sup>th</sup> Nov.** from 10.45pm. At 11am there will be two minutes silence, followed by the names of the fallen, the laying of wreaths, and a short Service. Mr. Stephen Trigg will lay the wreath on behalf of St. Mary's Catholic Community. Because of the timing of the Remembrance Service, the **Sunday Mass in St. Mary's will follow at 11.30am.** The Mass will be offered for the War Dead.

### COMING BACK TO SUNDAY MASS.

The Bishops of England and Wales have set aside the **First Sunday of Advent** as the "Day of the Lord" and to encourage those who have been away from Mass during the pandemic to think again, and to re-join the congregation in their parish churches. The Bishops call it our "renewed observance of the Day of the Lord."

### CHANGE IN THE CELEBRATION OF MASS.

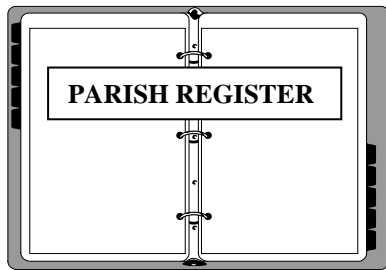
From the **First Sunday of Advent**, the following change will take place in the distribution of Holy Communion. From that Sunday, the beginning of the new Liturgical Year, the distribution of Holy Communion will revert to its normal place in the Mass (ie. immediately after the priest's communion). This means that people will return to their places after receiving Holy Communion and the Mass will be brought to a conclusion with the blessing and dismissal in the usual way. Covid restrictions are still in force and Stewards will be in place to direct the flow of communicants and to ensure that people leave the church via the side aisles after Mass.
