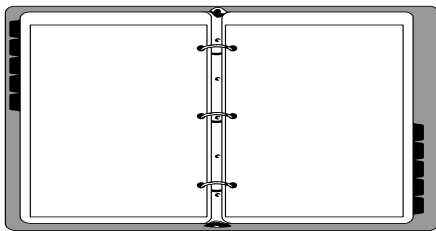

CAFOD Lenten Fast Day – Friday 27th February

The collection of the fast day envelopes (**given out next weekend 21st/22nd February**) will be taken up on the following weekend **28th/29th February**.

Storms, droughts and floods are having a devastating impact on our poorest brothers and sisters around the world right now. CAFOD works with local expert organisations to ensure affected people are not only able to survive, but to thrive. Fast Days are our opportunity to support that vital work. Whatever you give can help to ensure that long term, deep-rooted devastation from extreme weather doesn't become a fact of life.

A second Lenten Collection is taken on the 5th Sunday of Lent which is 21st /22nd March. This is the Archdiocesan Lenten Alms collection which is distributed by the Council of Priests to worthy causes and charities of their choice.

Please note that these Lenten appeals will have matching funding from the UK Government up to the value of £3.5m. **Donations between Ash Wednesday (18th February) and Sunday 17th May will be matched £1 for £1.**
