For those who have perhaps been away from the Sacrament for some time, as well as those who just want to make Confession part of their Lenten journey, a very warm welcome awaits them. No one will be judged.

This means that, every Wednesday until 16<sup>th</sup> April inclusive, *the Light is on for You* between 7pm and 8pm in St. Joseph's in Penarth. On Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> March. Fr Andy Bord (from St, Mary's, Canton), will hear Confessions, Canon Joe will be available on the subsequent Wednesdays.

On Wednesdays of Lent until 16<sup>th</sup> April inclusive, Confessions are also available from 7pm to 8pm at the following Cardiff churches: - St. David's Cathedral; St. Mary's, Canton; St. Brigids, Crystals; St. Francis, Ely; St. Joseph's, New Zealand Rd; Christ the King, Llanishen; St. Cadoc's, Llanrumney; St. Peter's, Roath; St. Alban's, Splott; St. John Lloyd, Trowbridge; Blessed Sacrament, Wentloog Road; St. Teilo, Whitchurch.
