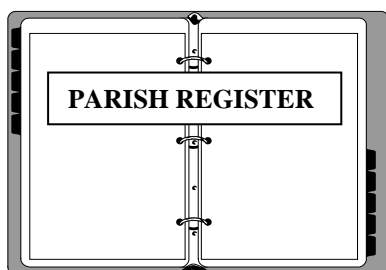

### PENTECOST NOVENA HAS STARTED.

The Bishops' Conference of England and Wales invites all Catholics to respond in prayer and action to the urgent climate change issues that we all face. This is a Novena of reading and prayers drawn from the Bible and recent Papal teaching.

Between Ascension and Pentecost, the Scriptures tell us: "All these with one accord were devoting themselves to prayer, together with the women and Mary the mother of Jesus, and his brothers" (Acts 1:14) while they awaited to be "clothed with power from on high." (Luke 24:49).

We are invited to pray these nine days reflecting on the account of creation in the book of Genesis. This Novena can be used on its own or to complement the prayers and reflections of the global prayer movement – "Thy Kingdom Come" with the Care of Creation theme.
