DAY FOR LIFE - TODAY

This year the **Day for Life** will focus on **all those who are suffering or have survived domestic abuse**. It provides an opportunity to pray, reflect, and to choose the ways in which action, as well as practical and emotional support, can **ensure the dignity of human life is upheld** at every stage of a person's life.

Following discussion about violence in the home and domestic violence at the Synod on the Family, **Pope Francis** wrote: 'Unacceptable customs still need to be **eliminated**. I think particularly of the **shameful ill-treatment to which women are sometimes subjected, domestic violence** and various forms of **enslavement** which, rather than a show of masculine power, are **craven acts of cowardice**. The verbal, physical and sexual violence that women endure in some marriages **contradicts** the very nature of the conjugal union.' (*Amoris Laetitia* 54).

Many people **do not have life to the full** because they are abused in their own homes. They have fallen victim to the **scourge of domestic abuse** which is an assault on a person's innate human dignity. Further information is to be found on the CEDAR website (www.cedar.uk.net).

There will be a second collection **TODAY** to support the crucial work of **Day for Life**. The proceeds from this collection enable the Church to fund the **Anscombe Bioethics Centre** (formerly the Linacre Centre for Healthcare Ethics), as well as projects which work to protect life at every stage and in every condition. **See handout.**
