BISHOP - ELECT PETER COLLINS

It was announced from Rome on Tuesday that The Holy Father has appointed Canon Peter Collins as the new Bishop of East Anglia. Canon Peter is currently parish priest of St Mary of the Angels, Canton, with Holy Family Fairwater. Archbishop Mark O'Toole wrote: "We offer Bishop – elect Peter our warmest congratulations and assurance of our prayers. While we will miss him, we all appreciate this appointment is right for Peter and for the Diocese of East Anglia. Any sense of loss we may feel, is placed within the context of God's providence and an awareness of the good of the whole church. We must be generous with our brother as he takes up this new mission and accompany him with our prayers and with our loving support." Bishop – elect Peter will be ordained Bishop on Wednesday 14th December at 11:30am at the Cathedral church of St. John the Baptist in Norwich.
