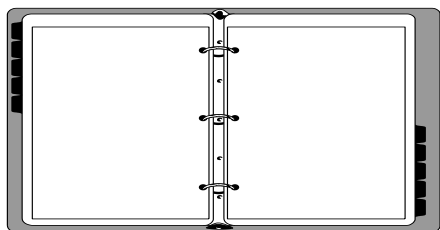

The Light is ON for US – during Advent.

"The Light is ON for You", invites practising and lapsed Catholics to go to Confession this Advent. In common with other dioceses across England and Wales, we are reaching out to those who may have wandered from the life of the Church and those Mass-going Catholics who have been away from Confession for some years. Each Wednesday of Advent, participating Catholic Parish Churches in the Archdiocese of Cardiff will be open from **7pm to 8pm on 3rd, 10th and 17th December** for Catholics to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation. This means that **'The Light is ON for You'** at these times in St. Joseph's, Penarth.

Mgr John Maguire, parish priest of St. Mary's, Canton will be hearing confessions in Penarth, while Canon Joe will go to Canton.
