WELSH NATIONAL PILGRIMAGE TO LOURDES – ANNUAL MASS AND SOCIAL GATHERING

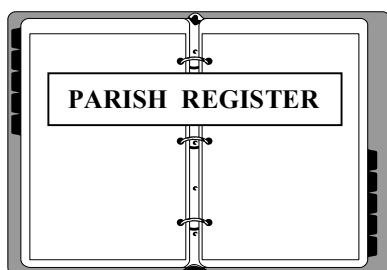
