CONFIRMATION

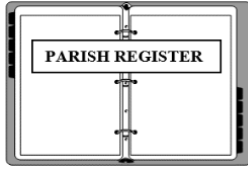
The next Confirmation meeting is on Monday 18th March at 7.30pm in St Mary's hall.
