#### LENTEN REFLECTIONS - WE DARE TO SAY.

Pope Francis has declared 2024 as a Year of Prayer in preparation for The Jubilee Year next year. We are to use the **Lord's Prayer** as our focus, deepening our understanding and our devotion to it. The Bishops Conference of England and Wales has produced a very helpful booklet entitled **'We Dare to Say'** to use on our Lenten journey.

The booklets are available at the back of both churches TODAY. Please take your copy as you leave the church. Through the 5 weeks of Lent we are asked to each use the weekly meditations in private, and then find a small group with whom to share it. This might be an established parish group eg. Justice & Peace, UCM, SVP, Music, Coffee Mornings, flowers, Ministries, and so on.

If you do not belong to an establish grouping, you can "go it alone" **OR** you can come to a series of meetings that will take place in our church halls on the Wednesdays of Lent at 7.30pm beginning this coming week in St. Joseph's hall. The weekly meetings will alternate between St Joseph's and St. Mary's. They will be led by Mgr. Joe.
