LENTEN PENITENTIAL SERVICES – THIS WEEK

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is part of our Lenten Journey. The Cardiff Deanery has organised the following three Penitential Services for Lent in three different locations.

- Tues 20th March in St. Helen's, Barry, from 7pm.
- Thurs 22nd March in St. Mary's, Canton from 1.30pm 3pm.
- Mon 26th March from 7pm. In St. Teilo's, Whitchurch. Four or five priests will be hearing confessions on each occasion. You don't have to be there at the starting time; priests will be available until at least 8pm in the evening slots, and 3pm at Canton, and will stay longer if anyone is still waiting at the "finish" time. There's no better way to prepare for Easter than a spring clean for your soul. Your priests are here for you.

FEAST OF ST. JOSEPH – 19th March

The feast of St. Joseph is on **Monday 19th** and we shall be celebrating the **patronal feast** of the parish community and the patronal feast of our primary school. The **Parish Mass** is at **9.30am** and the **Mass in the school** is at **2.30pm**. All welcome.

Otherwise the chaplaincy team will not know that the person is there. Due to the Data Protection Act, the team no longer has access to the list of Admissions. If no one from the Church has been to see the person in hospital, it is because they do not know the person is there.

WORLD MEETING OF FAMILIES

Dublin, Ireland, has been chosen by Pope Francis to hose the next World Meeting of Families from 21st – 26th August 2018, guided by the theme "The Gospel of the Family: Joy for the World".

Held every three years, this major international event brings together families from across the world to celebrate, pray and reflect upon the central importance of marriage and the family as the cornerstone of our lives, of society and of the Church. The event has at its heart the following key moments:

- 21st August, a National Opening of WMOF2018, which will take place simultaneously in all the different diocese of Ireland.
- 22nd 24th August, a three-day Congress. Each day will reflect on the theme "The Gospel of the Family: Joy for the World" chosen by the Holy Father and will include an enriching programme for adults of keynote speakers, workshops, talks, testimonials and discussions; an engaging and exciting programme for young people as well as fun activities for children. The Congress will also include daily celebration of the Eucharist, prayerful activities, exhibitions, cultural events and musical performances.
- Saturday 25th August, a Festival of Families, comprising a
 reflective concert style event within a prayerful and joyful
 atmosphere, in which personal stories of faith will be shared
 by families from all continents.
- Sunday 26th August, WMOF2018 will close with a solemn Eucharistic Celebration that will gather thousands of people from Ireland and all over the world.
