A BRIGHTER FUTURE.

Parish life has to go on despite the Covid-19 pandemic. We are now open again to public weekend Masses in St. Joseph's and the remedial work necessary on St. Mary's to repair the flood damage will commence on 26th April. Over the coming weeks and months therefore, we are hoping for a gradual return to a fuller experience of parish life.

THE WELSH GOV. AND PLACES OF WORSHIP.

The latest report (April 13th) from the Welsh Government regarding Places of Worship responded to questions raised by religious groups regarding two main areas of concern (among others) ie. a relaxation in social distancing to increase capacity and the return of congregational singing. With regard to social distancing, the WG said they would only begin to consider this after the envisaged vaccination of all the population. And then any change would only come when the level of risk was considered acceptable. The ban on congregational singing (indoors) is being re-investigated currently and could be part of a gradual easing of restrictions as the "road map out of Lockdown" rolls out. The WG agreed to bring these matters to the attention of the new administration after the Senedd elections on 6th May.

CONFESSIONS (St Joseph's) NEXT WEEK.

Confessions will be reinstated to their usual Saturday morning slot from next week (24th April) from **10am – 11am**. This will be for an initial period until the end of May. It will then be reviewed. Covid guidelines will be observed.

FIRST HOLY COMMUNIONS 2021.

We are going ahead with First Holy Communion for the children who missed out in 2020 due to cancellation. Parents have been contacted by the catechists. A special Mass will take place in St. Joseph's on **Saturday 5th June at 11am**. Attendance will be restricted to immediate family. The Mass will be streamed live for those unable to be there.

CONFIRMATION 2021.


Those youngsters who had to abandon the preparation classes last year after lockdown, have been invited to rejoin the group on zoom. The Sacrament of Confirmation will be celebrated in St. Joseph's on **Friday 18**th **June at 7pm**. Attendance is limited but the Mass will be streamed live.

RE-COMMENCING INFANT BAPTISM.

Mgr. Joe will be re-introducing Infant baptisms from **Sunday 2**nd **May**. The Services must comply with covid guidelines and so will differ in certain respects from the normal baptismal liturgy. The new time will be 3pm on Sundays in St. Joseph's and the maximum number of people present will be 15. Parents are asked to phone the presbytery and make an appointment to meet with the parish priest either on zoom or face-to-face at the back of the church. (Covid-friendly)
