DAY FOR LIFE – 18th June (TODAY)

In October, it will be **50 years** since the passing of the **1967 Abortion Act** in Wales, Scotland and England. This **sad anniversary** will be marked in various ways. The **Day for Life** this year will provide us with an **opportunity to pray for and remember** all those lives lost before birth and to offer practical, spiritual and emotional support to **women and men** who have been **affected by issues surrounding abortion** or who are worried and concerned about unwanted pregnancy. For those who have had an abortion, the words of **Pope Francis** will be a comfort and a challenge: "...there is no sin that God's mercy cannot reach and wipe away when it finds a repentant heart seeking to be reconciled to the Father". Proceeds from this collection are allocated to the **Anscombe Bioethics Centre** and other Church supported life activities.

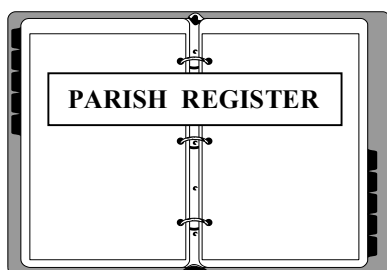
COFFEE MORNING: St. Cecilia Centre, Lesotho
