DAY FOR LIFE THIS WEEKEND.

The Church teaches that life is to be nurtured from conception to natural death. In England and Wales, Day for Life is celebrated on the third Sunday of June each year. This year it falls on 18th June. The theme is "Listen to her" and focuses on post-abortion trauma and the impact of abortion primarily on women, but also on men.

A second collection will be taken at each Mass. The funds raised also support the Anscombe Bio-Ethics Centre which advises the Bishops' Conference on medical issues.

NO MORNING MASS ON THURSDAY

There will be no parish mass at 9:30 in St Joseph's on Thursday as Mgr Joe will be joining his brother priests in the Cathedral at 11:30, when the Apostolic Nuncio, Archbishop Miguel Maury Buendia will present Archbishop Mark with his Pallium on becoming a Metropolitan Archbishop. The Pallium is a white band of material with black crosses that rests over the Archbishops Chasuble on his shoulder when he is saying Mass. The Pallium is his "badge of office".

FIRST HOLY COMMUNIONS

After the First Holy Communions in Saint Mary's last week, there was a special Mass in St Joseph's yesterday when twelve of our St. Joseph's children received the Lord in Holy Communion for the very first time. Like St. Mary's it was a parish event, but this time specific to the community in St Joseph's. The children will be present again at the 9:30 Mass on Sunday morning, dressed once again in their first Holy Communion attire. There will be coffee in the hall after Mass.
