### THE ROLLER-COASTER RIDE WE ARE ON.

The Coronavirus pandemic has become something of a roller-coaster ride as we lurch from peaks to troughs and then back again, with now another spike in the graph to face, which threatens to overwhelm our hospitals again, disrupt the education of our children once more, and perhaps do irreversible damage to the fragile economy that could cost many people their jobs and livelihoods.

One of the unfortunate spin-offs to this pandemic has to be the uncertainty it brings. How can we plan anything while the ground rules are changing almost from day to day?

We have just opened both our churches, albeit to limited congregations, and attendances are going well. However, another total lockdown is now being contemplated by the politicians which could close our church doors once again. Notwithstanding this uncertainty, Mgr. Joe has to think about the celebration of the other Sacraments too, the ones that didn't happen this year because of Coronavirus and were deferred until next year. It involves Confirmation, First Holy Communion, and also Infant Baptisms. Unfortunately because of the unpredictability of events and with the practicalities of social distancing etc. it is not possible to plan that far ahead at the present time. Mgr. Joe is waiting for the mist of uncertainty to clear a little, so that perhaps in the New Year, he can look at the situation again and exercise a more balanced judgement. We can only wait and see.

**We shall celebrate these Sacraments as soon as it is safe to do so, for the children and all involved.**

Please advise Mgr. Joe of the number attending each Mass.

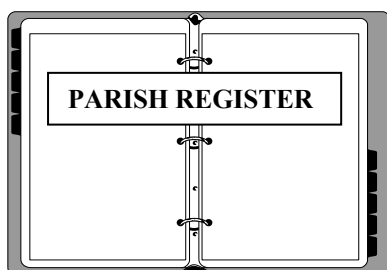
### CAFOD HARVEST FAST DAY COLLECTION.
