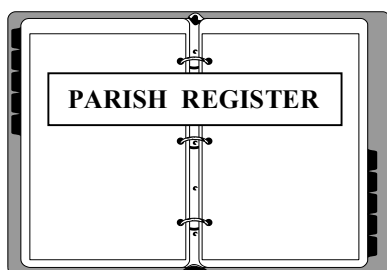
The next meeting of the SVP will be on **Tuesday 21st February** in **St. Mary's Hall**.
