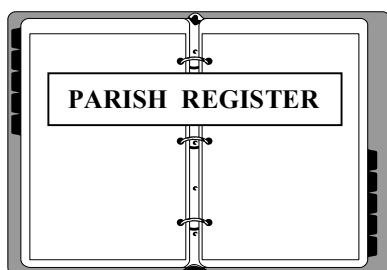

FAST DAY – *Thank you to all parishioners at St. Joseph's and St. Mary's for your generous support for CAFOD this year and for your latest donation of £2,086.42 which we received on 16 April 2019.*

Your generous support for CAFOD Family Fast Day this Lent means that Mahinur's family and community in Bangladesh can receive the help they need. We will be able to fund training in new farming skills, provide hardy seeds that will grow despite salty floodwater or droughts and give chickens and ducks for families to breed and sell. We will also teach trades like mechanics and tailoring so people are not so reliant on farming in the unpredictable weather.

It is always wonderful to see the transformation and joy in communities overseas that is made possible by efforts of the Catholic community at home.
