#### COFFEE MORNING AND BOOK SWAP

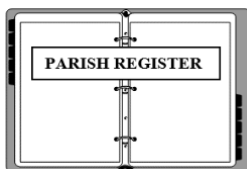

We hear in the Gospel today how Jesus fed the crowds: he took bread, blessed it, broke it and gave it to them. These are the same actions that are at the heart of every Mass.
