### ANNUAL MASS COUNT.

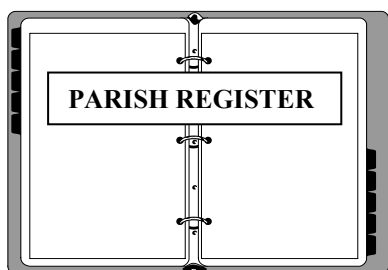

### SEASON OF CREATION – ANOTHER ASPECT.

There is a new report, commissioned by Catholic organisations including CAFOD called "The wailing of God's creatures". It looks at the loss of biodiversity and the extinction of species, Catholic social teaching, and human activity. It concludes that most of the species loss is caused by changes in land use, over exploitation and over consumption, pollution and climate change, and that creation is no longer able to support further loss of biodiversity.
