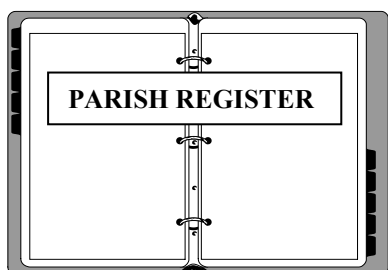
MAY SHE REST IN PEACE

On this day we are asked to remember seafarers and fishers in our prayers and to hold a **second collection** for the Catholic Charity Stella Maris (formerly called Apostleship of the Sea).
