Today Sunday 20th September – Home Mission Sunday – a second collection will be taken.

This is the day in the Church's calendar when the bishops invite every member of the Catholic community to pray for, celebrate and support the work of evangelisation in England and Wales. Thank you in advance for your generosity. This year's theme is PROCLAIM God's Mercy – in anticipation of the Jubilee Year of Mercy, called by Pope Francis, which begins in December this year. "How much I desire that the year to come will be steeped in mercy, so that we can go out to every man and woman, bringing the goodness and tenderness of God! May the balm of mercy reach everyone". (Pope Francis – Misericordia Vultus 5). A Joint Pastoral Letter from Cardinal Vincent Nichols and Archbishop Peter Smith on behalf of the Bishops of England and Wales will be read out at Masses.
