Fifty young adults and their helpers will be travelling to Krakow in Poland for the last two weeks in July 2016. They will be joining Pope Francis for the World Youth Day, which reaches its climax with his visit to the city at the end of July. A programme of spiritual and cultural events has been prepared for the young people and there will be preparations here in Cardiff in the coming year to prepare them for what will undoubtedly be an experience of a lifetime. Although all places have currently been taken, **there is a waiting list should a vacancy occur.** There is also a 'Priests Program', and some of the clergy will join our young pilgrims for the days in Krakow. There will also be opportunities for sponsorship and fund raising in parishes to help fund the pilgrims.
