ST. MARY'S TO REOPEN SOON.

Monsignor Joe is pleased to announce that we have at last received the green light for St. Mary's church in Dinas Powys to re-open for public worship. This is no mean feat, taking into account the complexities of the Health & Safety Risk Assessments involved. I am grateful to the small team of helpers for their time and expertise during this protracted process. Thanks also to the Stewards who have helped us to navigate through the maze of Coronavirus regulations. This therefore will be the "trigger" for two things to happen: Firstly, the 11.15am Mass on Sunday morning will return to St. Mary's on **Sunday 4th October**.

Secondly, on the same day, **4**th **October**, the **9.30am** Sunday morning Mass in St. Joseph's will be re-established. A second Sunday Mass, means that we will need extra stewards to supervise and guide parishioners so that the maximum number of people can be in attendance at Mass, in accordance with social distancing regulations.

If you intend coming to the 9.30am Sunday Mass why not volunteer to be **a steward**. You will be on a Rota with others and you will only be called upon at intervals.
