WEEKDAY MASSES IN LLANDOUGH HOSPITAL

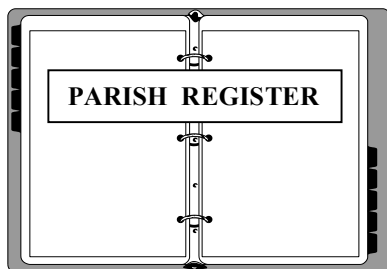

ROSWITHA'S RTU VISIT TO INDIA

Roswitha recently returned from her visit to a village in India with **RTU** (Reaching the Unreached). She took funds, raised by family, friends and parishioners for a **bore well** in drought stricken **South India**, where the monsoon has **failed** in the last **4 years** and the water table has been dropping at an alarming rate. She was very fortunate to be present at the drilling of the well for a **primary school with 120 pupils** in a remote village (**25 miles from the RTU campus**). They had not had their own drinking water for years and had to **walk to the village well** each lunchtime to carry water back to the school. When the pipes from the new well had been laid, Roswitha was the first to turn on the tap and crystal clear water came out to the jubilation of the children and the staff! **The well is called: Wales Water!** Thank you to you all who contributed to this **life changing water** for the children in South India. In due course, there will be a talk with photos.
