WE ARE WELCOMING YOU BACK.

From next Sunday, the First Sunday of Advent, the Bishops of England and Wales want to welcome you back to Sunday Mass. They are asking all Catholics everywhere to reflect deeply on the centrality of Sunday worship in the life of the Church. They are issuing the invitation to those who have been away, to restore the Sunday Mass to its rightful centrality in their lives. (However, the elderly and vulnerable should only come back if it is safe for them to do so).

CHANGE IN THE CELEBRATION OF MASS.

From NEXT WEEK, the First Sunday of Advent, the following change will take place in the distribution of Holy Communion. From next Sunday, on the first Sunday of the new Liturgical year, the distribution of Holy Communion will revert to its normal place in the Mass (ie. immediately after the priest's communion). This means that people will return to their places after receiving Holy Communion and the Mass will be brought to a conclusion with the blessing and dismissal in the usual way. Stewards will be in place to direct the flow of communicants and to ensure that people leave the church via the side aisles after Mass.
