### WELCOME BACK.

Last weekend we removed the barrier tape from the pews in both our churches as the restrictions on social distancing were lifted. This meant that more parishioners were able to come to Mass and, most importantly, were able to receive Our Blessed Lord in Holy Communion.

For those who might still prefer to maintain a safe distance from the person next to them, there are "Leave a Space" cards available and stewards will explain how to use them. We are only too aware that **THE VIRUS HAS NOT GONE AWAY** and some of the basic precautions against Covid-19 must remain in place. Face masks must continue to be worn by everyone, sanitising gel must be applied on entry, details for Track & Trace purposes will still be required, and the one-way system for entry and exit will continue.

All in all, we have taken the first tentative steps on our journey out of Covid restrictions. There are other things we are looking at but which we cannot bring back at the moment. The unfolding situation will be monitored and reviewed at regular intervals.

### MASSES WILL CONTINUE AS AT PRESENT.

The weekend Masses in St. Joseph's and St Mary's **with a congregation** (on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday) will remain the same and will stick to the same format. One small difference is the re-introduction of Lay Readers, who will once again proclaim the Word of God. Other weekday Masses in St. Joseph's on Monday and Wednesday

mornings will have to continue behind closed doors, until such time as the presence of Stewards is no longer required. ### PAT BETHELL R.I.P.




