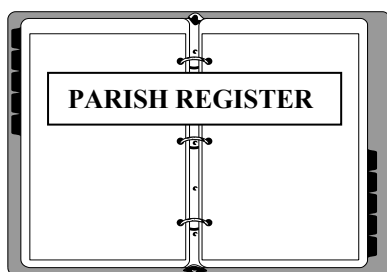

### TOILETRIES DROP SATURDAY 5TH DEC.

The J&P Group is requesting a pre-Christmas drop of Toiletries for Sister Ruth of the Daughters of Charity, who works with destitute asylum seekers in Newport Rd. Cardiff. The Group have already organised a previous drop this year in July, which was very successful despite the Lockdown that was prevalent at the time. **The plan is this:-**  
On Saturday 5<sup>th</sup> December, between 2pm and 3pm, a car belonging to a member of the J&P Group will be parked in front of the presbytery in St. Joseph's, and another one in the car park in St. Mary's, Dinas Powys, Donors are asked to put their toiletries in a bag which can be placed in the boot of the J&P car. There will be no need for any physical contact and social distancing will be observed at all times. Sister Ruth says that their current priorities are: soap, shower gel, shampoo, toothpaste and toothbrushes, deodorants, shaving cream, toilet rolls, female sanitary products, hand cream, and hand sanitisers.
