FORTHCOMING COLLECTION – next week, Priests' Training Fund:

Next Sunday is a day of Prayer for Vocations to the priesthood and religious life. "Behind every vocation, there is always the prayer of someone...." (Pope Francis reminds us). We have seen the fruits of our prayers in recent years with the ordination of 8 priests for this Archdiocese in as many years. Dale Cutlan, from Aberdare, is our remaining seminarian, and he is due to be ordained a "transitional" deacon – ie. in transit to the priesthood – later this year. Next year, please God, he will be ordained a priest. (His photo is on the leaflets that are being handed out today). Please keep him in your prayers,

THE SECOND COLLECTION NEXT WEEK will be for the Priests' Training Fund (PTF). On average, it takes £189,000 per student over the 7 years of formation. This capital outlay is well worth it because as a priest, he may give back more than 40 or 50 year's service to the Church over his lifetime. The Priests' Training Fund needs to be "topped up" each year to meet the costs. Special envelopes will be given out this weekend and you are asked to consider bringing them back next week containing your contribution. (Tax payers can gift aid their donation). You can also choose to donate regularly by standing order. At the back of both churches you will see a Poster displayed drawing your attention to the appeal. This Poster contains a QR Code which can be scanned on your phone and you can then give as directed.

SPUC PRO LIFE CHAIN CARDIFF

The Cardiff annual SPUC pro-life chain will take place on Saturday 29th April 2023 at 11:00 AM to 1:00 PM the usual place outside Whitchurch high school, Manor way, Cardiff, near the traffic lights. 10 million unborn children have now died in the UK as a result of surgical or chemical abortions. Just as many have died resulting from the morning after pill euphemistically known as emergency contraception.

SAINT OF THE WEEK. St. Catherine of Sienna.

Born in Sienna in 1347 and wanting to follow the way of perfection, she entered the Third Order of St. Dominic while still an adolescent. She brought peace and harmony between her fellow citizens, and through her personal influence, many people returned to the faith under her guidance. Her crowning achievement was when she persuaded Pope Gregory X1 to return the Papacy to Rome from Avignon, where for 2 generations, the papacy had been under the dominance of the French Monarchy. She also did much for the renewal of religious life. Her writings are renowned for their spirituality and sound doctrine, and for this Pope Paul V1 declared her Doctor of the Church. She has since been recognised also as Patron of Europe. Catherine is a remarkable Saint because she was a remarkable woman. Her achievements were remarkable considering the role of women in medieval Italy. She died in 1380 at the age of just 33yrs.
