**HOME ACCESS FORTHCOMING COLLECTION – IN TWO WEEKS TIME ie. Weekend 5<sup>th</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> August.** For many years now we have supported the homeless through the local charity **Home Access**. The charity, at Tabernacle Baptist Church, Penarth, helps clients to secure suitable accommodation; it provides bonds to landlords for this purpose. The properties are inspected prior to clients moving in. They also assist clients to obtain housing benefits and check that entitlements are secured. Clients are followed up so they are not forgotten. Funding is needed to maintain this voluntary service so **your contributions are much appreciated.**
