### THE PARABLE OF THE WHEAT & THE DARNEL

The parable of the wheat and the darnel goes some way to explain why the evil in our World seemingly goes unpunished. It describes the World as we know it. A field of wheat gently growing is damaged by the introduction and planting of Darnel, which looks very much the same as wheat, but which is in fact poisonous. Shall we uproot it? No. Let things be, until harvest time, and then all shall be put right. It is hard to be patient with the hurt and harm we see being done in our World. But we cannot mend this broken World ourselves, and violent force will not solve our problems. God is patient, which means God suffers, and that is the road we can follow.

### WORLD DAY FOR GRANDPARENTS AND THE ELDERLY. TODAY

This third annual Day for Grandparents and the Elderly takes place this Sunday 23<sup>rd</sup> July, the fourth Sunday of July. Pope Francis instituted this day in 2021 since he believes grandparents are often forgotten, yet they "are the link between generations, passing on the experience of life and faith to the young", Pope Francis chose as this year's theme "His mercy is from age to age" which expresses the link with World Youth Day, 1<sup>st</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> Aug. 2023 which will take place shortly thereafter in Lisbon, Portugal. The World Youth Day's theme; "Mary arose and went with haste" shows us, how the young Mary sets out to go and find her elderly cousin, Elizabeth, and who loudly proclaims, in the Magnificat, the strength of the alliance between young and old. Today the Holy Father will preside over a Eucharistic Liturgy in St. Peter's Basilica and he invites parishes, dioceses, associations and ecclesial communities from all over the world to celebrate the Day in their own pastoral context.
