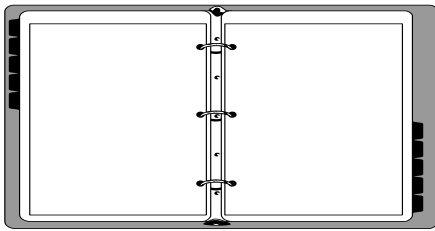

### Reflections on Bereavement – Month of November

Trained bereavement support volunteers will be available to listen and to talk with anyone who wishes to do so; there will also be reflective spots set up for people who just want to sit and reflect and pray.

This year 'Walk with me' speaks of the **kerygma**, the message of God's saving love.
